RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHEAST MONMOUTH MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO PURCHASE TWO (2) REPLACEMENT HYPOCHOLORITE CHEMICAL FEED PUMPS AND LIGHT FIXTURES.

WHEREAS, the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") serves the Township of Wall, the Borough of Brielle, the Borough of Sea Girt, the Borough of Spring Lake and the Borough of Spring Lake Heights and is comprised of member municipalities which receive treated water from the Authority; and

WHEREAS, within the operating budget of the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority funds have been reserved within the Renewal and Replacement Reserve Account for the renewal and replacement of equipment for the Water Treatment Plant located on Hospital Road in Wall, NJ; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Water Supply Authority's operations and maintenance staff recently identified the need for an immediate purchase of two (2) hypochlorite chemical feed pumps for delivering liquid chlorine to the raw and finished water at the Water Treatment Plant and for the replacement of light fixtures to comply with federal guidelines; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority that it hereby authorizes the New Jersey Water Supply authority to proceed with the purchase and installation of two (2) hypochlorite chemical feed pumps and the purchase and installation of lighting fixtures at the Water Authority Plant pursuant to the

funds allocated within the renewal and replacement reserve account of the Southeast Monmouth Utilities Authority budget, at a total cost not to exceed \$14,000.00.
