RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHEAST MONMOUTH MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PURCHASES AND ASSOCIATED LABOR FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$86,000.00 AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DAVE HEINER ASSOCIATES, INC.

WHEREAS, the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") serves the Township of Wall, the Borough of Brielle, the Borough of Sea Girt, the Borough of Spring Lake and the Borough of Spring Lake Heights and is comprised of member municipalities which receive treated water from the Authority; and

WHEREAS, within the operating budget of the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority funds have been reserved for Capital Improvement Purchases within the Capital Improvement Fund for the Water Treatment Plant located on Hospital Road in Wall, NJ; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Water Supply Authority's operations and maintenance staff recently identified the need for a replacement of the Automated Polymer Feed System at the Water Treatment Plant which will include a vacuum hopper loader, screw feeder and wetting system, mix tank, pump tank and control system for aging and diluting the polymer. Also included are two new liquid chemical fee pumps with valves, gauges, feed control and alarm system; and

WHEREAS, bids were advertised on February 6, 2014 and Dave Heiner Associates, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$82,210.00; and

WHEREAS, the installation and wiring associated with the Automated Polymer Feed System will be performed by the Water Authority maintenance staff for an estimated cost of \$3,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the Capital Improvements is expected not to exceed the amount of \$86,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority that it hereby authorizes use of the Capital Improvement Fund by the New Jersey Water Supply Authority to proceed with the Capital Improvement Purchases and associated labor for the Automated Polymer Feed System at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant for an amount not to exceed \$86,000.00, and to award the contract to Dave Heiner Associates, Inc. for an amount of \$82,210.00.
