The filters are 14 years old and should have lasted longer and the problem is the improper grouting. They have hired the same engineer to analyze and to write specifications to have a contractor come in to work on and will go out to bid for the other two boxes as it won't be the summer usage time. They have rented a trailer mounted filter unit to relieve the two units and are awaiting approval from the DEP to use it. The rental cost is within their operating budget.
