**RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHEAST MONMOUTH MUNICIPAL UTILITIES  
AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PURCHASE OF  
PORTABLE OZONE GAS DETECTOR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,480.00**

**WHEREAS**, the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the “Authority”) serves the Township of Wall, the Borough of Brielle, the Borough of Sea Girt, the Borough of Spring Lake and the Borough of Spring Lake Heights and is comprised of member municipalities which receive treated water from the Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, within the operating budget of the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority funds have been reserved for Capital Improvement Purchases within the Capital Improvement Fund for the Water Treatment Plant located on Hospital Road in Wall, NJ; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Water Supply Authority’s operations and maintenance staff recently identified the need for identifying the location of minor piping leaks and, therefore, purchasing a new portable ozone gas detector; and

**WHEREAS**, the total cost for the Capital Improvement is expected to be in the amount of \$1,480.00; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority that it hereby authorizes use of the Capital Improvement Fund by the New Jersey Water Supply Authority to proceed with the Capital Improvement Purchase for a portable ozone gas detector at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant for an amount not to exceed \$1,480.00.
