**RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHEAST MONMOUTH MUNICIPAL UTILITIES
AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PURCHASE OF A
PUMP ASSEMBLY FROM LONGO ELECTRICAL MECHANICAL.**

WHEREAS, the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the “Authority”) serves the Township of Wall, the Borough of Brielle, the Borough of Sea Girt, the Borough of Spring Lake and the Borough of Spring Lake Heights and is comprised of member municipalities which receive treated water from the Authority; and

WHEREAS, within the operating budget of the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority funds have been reserved for the Capital Improvement Purchases within the Capital Improvement Fund for the Water Treatment Plant located on Hospital Road in Wall, NJ; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Water Supply Authority’s Asset Management and Engineering staff recently identified the need for replacing the pump assembly of filter water pump number one at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the purchase of the pump assembly, at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant is in the amount of \$94,400.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority that it hereby authorizes the New Jersey Water Supply Authority to proceed with the use of funds from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a pump assembly from the lowest responsible bidder, Longo Electrical Mechanical, at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant for an amount of \$94,400.00 to cover the cost of this expense.
