MEETING MINUTES
March 5, 2026

The Southeast Monmouth Municipal Utilities Authority members met on March 5, 2026. Present were Brielle Borough representative Tom Nolan, Wall Township representative John Tobia, Spring Lake Heights representative Connor Kessler, and Spring Lake Borough representative Bryan Dempsey. Also present were attorney Mark Kitrick, Steve Mayer and NJWSA Plant Manager Anthony Colasurdo. Sea Girt representative Justin Macko was absent.

Anthony further stated, in regards to the plant expansion plan, they are reviewing the RFP and will provide to H2M soon for input.
